This letter is being provided in lieu of a certificate of insurance for the self-insured risks.

Walgreens and its subsidiaries maintain a comprehensive program of insurance and self-insurance to protect our company interests as required by the terms of our signed contract and/or agreement. Our signed contracts and/or agreements allow us the option to self-insure the risk of loss for Property and we have chosen to take that option.

Coverages for all Professional Liability (Pharmacists, Nurses, PBM, Architects, and Lawyers) exposures are outlined in the signed contract or agreement and we are obligated to provide such coverage per the limits outlined in the signed contract and/or agreement. The Professional Liability self-insurance provided by Walgreens is the same as that which can be purchased in the standard commercial insurance marketplace.

The self-insured proceeds are for the benefit of Walgreens Vendors, Clients, and any other party, who requires such coverage, per the terms of a signed contract and/or agreement. A Waiver of Subrogation also applies, where applicable.

Walgreens no longer issues individualized Certificates of Insurance or Memorandums of Insurance as these customized documents will not strengthen the coverage. The existence of the signed contract and/or agreement triggers protection under our insurance and self-insurance programs. Please accept this letter as evidence of insurance, per the terms of the signed contract and/or agreement, and apply it to ALL Walgreens commitments with similar terms.

Please forward this letter to any party that may require the information as part of a signed contract, lease, and/or agreement with Walgreens.
